#### **ASEAN Smart Cities Network Partnership**

The ASEAN Smart Cities Network (ASCN), established in 2018 with 26 pilot cities from the 10 ASEAN Member States, is an international, interurban platform for cities to work together toward smarter and more sustainable cities across the region.

In 2019, WeGO undertook a series of activities to support ASCN cities through matchmaking with partners, consultants, and solution providers, through a workshop for knowledge sharing and a mayoral conference with signing ceremonies for partnerships. In the coming year, WeGO will continue its support for the network and stakeholders for the implementation of smart city action plans,







#### **Northeast Asia Smart Cities Network Establishment**

#### **WeGO Smart Sustainable Cities Training Program**

Annual training program held in partnership with the Seoul Human Resource Development Center for WeGO member cities' officials to learn about leading trends in smart cities based on Seoul's global leadership in the field.

#### **WeGO-NIA Joint Workshop**

Annual workshop organized to provide knowledge exchange and case sharing opportunities among WeGO members and partners. Lectures from experts and technical tours provide participants understanding of the Korean smart city trajectory for benchmarking.

#### WeGO-ICONLOOP Joint Feasibility Study & Pilot Project

Joint feasibility study on blockchain technology. Beneficiary city(s) will receive expert consultation and an opportunity to carry out a pilot project for the application of blockchain technology in the improvement of urban management systems and public services. Services to be provided will be at an estimated USD 120,000.

## **PRODUCTS & SERVICES**

## WeGO ACTIVATOR

An innovative, comprehensive online platform that will help cities plan, finance, and deploy their smart city projects. Once prepared for launch by WeGO, members will be able to manage their projects with sophisticated templates and analytics that will serve to guide them through a broad range of processes. The activator will also serve as a database of projects from around the world, where members can connect with peers and benchmark comparable projects for the success of their own.



## WeGO Smart Sustainable City Projects Catalog

An online archive currently with around 30 case studies on smart city best practice worldwide, which members can reference when approaching their own projects. For each entry, key areas needed for successful implementation are indicated and supported by statistics, budgetary figures, and impact assessments. The projects catalog will be merged into the activator once the latter becomes fully functional.



#### **Civic Participation System (CPS)**

As part of WeGO's Feasibility Study 2015, the Civic Participation System (CPS) was introduced as an innovative alternative to the outdated, vertical model of government-to-citizen communication, as a dynamic space for inclusive and interactive dialogue — horizontally, among a diversity of stakeholders — to solve the expansive series of urban challenges we share. In July 2018, it was enhanced with extra functions and made available free of charge to all members, with paid options for plus and premium features.
