## ABOUT WeGO

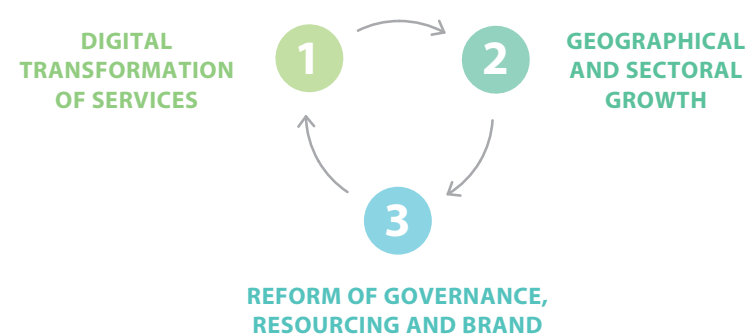

Identify project stakeholders to plan, execute, monitor, and evaluate smart city projects.

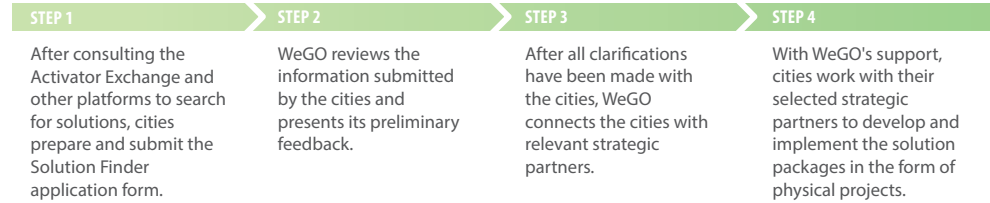
EXCHANGE

Share and benchmark best practices through a global directory of smart city projects.



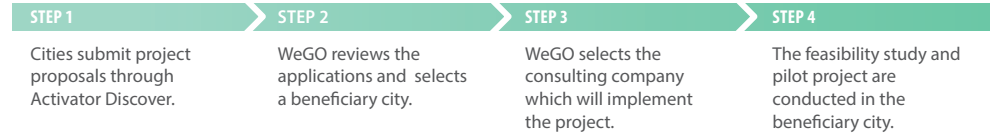
SOLUTION FINDER

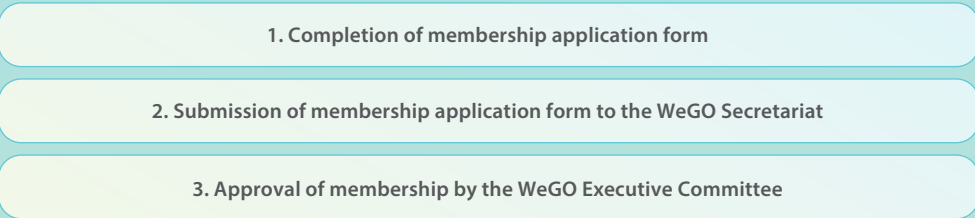
