SOLUTION FINDER

The WeGO Solution Finder aims at helping cities identify their urban challenges, design their own unique "solution packages", and be connected with smart city consultants, tech companies, development aid agencies, and other strategic partners that can help in the development and implementation of smart city projects.

After consulting the Activator Exchange and other platforms to search for solutions, cities prepare and submit the Solution Finder application form.	WeGO reviews the information submitted by the cities and presents its preliminary feedback. With WeGO's support, cities work with their selected strategic partners to develop and implement the solution packages in the form of physical projects.

PROJECT IMPLEMENTER

Formerly branded as the "Smart Sustainable City Feasibility Study Program, or "F/S," the WeGO Project Implementer selects project proposals submitted by WeGO member cities, and provides financial support and technical assistance to beneficiary cities to facilitate their transformation into smart sustainable cities.
