


















































May 22-24 | New Delhi, India



Asia's largest trade fair and conference on smart cities, featuring plenary sessions and panel discussions for the sharing of best practices across a broad range of smart tech areas related to buildings, solar, transport, and water.





# JUNE - SEPTEMBER

## Smart City Expo LATAM Congress

July 2-4 | Puebla, Mexico



Latin American equivalent of the Smart City Expo World Congress usually held in Barcelona, Spain. Serves as a regional meeting point for governments, companies, social entrepreneurs, and research centers to strengthen capacities and increase collaboration toward the development of cities.



## World Cities Summit Mayors Forum

July 10-12 | Medellín, Colombia



Annual event inviting mayors and senior leaders of international organizations and the industry to exchange experiences in developing integrated urban solutions, building economic and environmental resilience, engaging with communities, and sustaining a high quality of life in urban regions.

## WeGO-NIA-WB Workshop

July 15-18 | Jeju, Korea



Four-day smart city workshop for local and central government officials, co-organized with the National Information Society Agency of Korea and the World Bank.

## Smart and Secure Cities and Communities Challenge Expo

July 10-12 | Washington DC, US



Largest smart city event, with 1,500+ attendees, connected to Global City Teams Challenge (GCTC) - an initiative by the US Department of Commerce's National Institute of Standards and Technology (NIST) - convening close to 100 action clusters to showcase their accomplishments.



## ITU – Busan Young ICT Leaders Forum

August/September | Busan, Korea



Event co-organized with ITU and Busan Metropolitan City promoting the active participation of youth in the digital economy as future leaders of ICT and focusing on decreasing the digital divide through research on emerging technologies such as IoT.

## ITU Asia-Pacific Regional Forum

September | Bangkok, Thailand



Annual forum for the Asia-Pacific region serving as a platform for knowledge sharing and discussion on IoT, big data, security, and other smart city-related issues, along with networking between policymakers, regulators, industries, NGOs, and academia.



# OCTOBER - DECEMBER

## Urban Innovation Challenge: Citypreneurs

May 20 - October 1 | Seoul, Korea



Competition for startups from around the world interested in solving urban issues and achieving the UN SDGs, co-organized with domestically based agencies of the UN (WFUNA, UNESCAP, UNDP), Seoul Digital Foundation and Seoul Metropolitan Government.



## EXCOM 2019: Advancing Human-Centered Smart Cities

October 14-16 | Seongnam, Korea



Annual statutory meeting of WeGO Executive Committee members, to decide on key agendas and the strategic direction of the organization. It is organized in partnership with the host city alongside a series of sessions and technical and cultural tours.



## Seoul Smart City Summit

October 1 | Seoul, Korea



Annual event featuring a roundtable gathering the Mayor of Seoul, mayors from around the world and heads of global IT corporations to discuss and share their visions, challenges, and innovative solutions for smart sustainable cities.

## WeGO – ADB Workshop

October | Seongnam, Korea



Workshop co-organized with the Asian Development Bank (ADB) that aims to exchange knowledge on Korea's best smart-city practices to ADB clients. To take place during the WeGO Executive Committee Meeting (EXCOM) and/or the Seoul Smart City Summit.

## 4<sup>th</sup> WeGO Smart Sustainable City Awards

December | Online



Traditionally held in the same year as the WeGO General Assembly, it aims to encourage the incorporation of innovative ICT for the enhancement of administrative efficiency; increase citizens' access to public services; and share knowledge on smart city strategies actively.



## Homo Sapiencity Roadshow II

December 11 | Seoul, Korea



End-of-the-year event for local partners and the diplomatic community in Korea, including site visits, talks on policy and other smart city initiatives by private and public sector representatives, and concluded by a networking dinner.

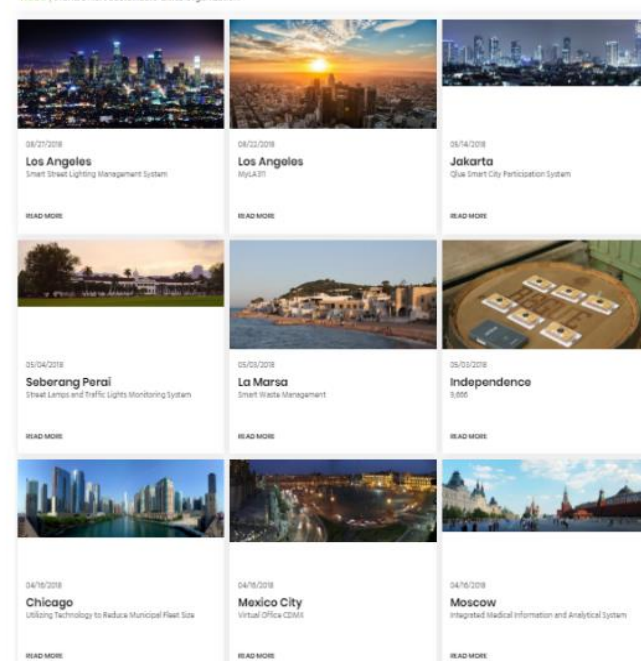
