COVID – 19 PRECAUTIONS OF SULTANBEYLI MUNICIPALITY

Sultanbeyli Municipality (Istanbul) has taken certain preventive measures against the spread of coronavirus and has been offering services to its residents. Here are some examples:

DISENFECTION ACTIVITIES

Sultanbeyli Municipality continues to carry out its disinfection activities against the Covid-19.

The municipality has disinfected 9 district bazaars, 78 avenues, 13 streets, 450 garbage containers, 51 public service buildings, 15 muhtars' offices, 56 parks, 114 places of worship, 28 health institutions, 70 pharmacies, 143 public transportation vehicles and 25 service bus until now.



RAISING AWARENESS ACTIVITIES

The municipality also carries out awareness raising activities regarding preventive measures against COVID-19. In many central points of the district, awareness banners were hung on billboards and boards in order to keep the local people informed.

In addition to this, warning announcements are made to district residents every day with a broadcast vehicle around all neighbourhoods.



OTHER PRECAUTIONS

Public security teams continue to carry out regular inspections at the supermarkets and marketplaces in order to ensure that the precautions are followed by the local people.

Administrative procedures are applied for those who do not comply with the related rules. 2,616 workplaces, 326 markets and 9 marketplaces were inspected in total.



PRECAUTIONS TAKEN AT MARKETPLACES

To prevent the spread of the virus in marketplaces, disinfectants and sanitizer dispensers have been placed at the entrance of district bazaars.

People were delivered masks and informed about what they need to do to protect themselves and their families. Also, a social distancing must be kept at the bazaars from at least 3 meters away.



ONLINE MUNICIPALITY SERVICES

With E-municipal applications that can be accessed through the municipality's corporate web site, district residents can carry out their transactions online by following the call "Stay at Home". In this context, people can make their tax payments digitally.

The trainings given by the Youth Centers have been started to be given via distance education system.

SUPPORT SERVICES FOR PEOPLE AGED OVER 65

The municipality continues its support activities for people aged over 65, who are considered as the biggest risk group of the epidemic and cannot leave the house. The elder people are served hot meals twice a day. The meals are cooked in the cafeteria of the municipality and then delivered to homes by the teams in accordance with the hygiene and health rules.

Additionally, the homes of elderly people have been disinfected and their basic needs such as food and cleaning materials are being met. Support teams makes market and pharmacy shopping for them.



EMPLOYMENT SUPPORT SERVICES

In order to prevent corona virus outbreak measures from affecting employment negatively in Sultanbeyli, job applications of unemployed people have been received.

In line with the relevant plans, a total of 338 people were directed to various jobs.



HOTLINE SERVICE

During the epidemic, the call center was set up to enable its citizens to report their demands easily and quickly.

Depending on the requests received, the relevant department teams quickly set to work to meet the needs.



FEEDING OF STREET ANIMALS

The epidemic has had an impact on the lives of street animals. All restaurants, cafes and other social gathering places have been closed to halt the spread of the coronavirus. As a result, a lot of street animals have had difficulty finding food and water.

The municipality is making concerted efforts to provide food and water for the country's street animals to keep them from going hungry given the large absence of activity on the streets.



MEDICAL WASTES ARE SEPARATED

Medical waste is separated from other waste by placing gray waste boxes in different points of the district like muhtars building and supermarkets and marketplaces where only masks and gloves will be collected.



TECHNOLOGICAL DEVICE CAMPAIGN

A campaign titled "Let's See Each Other in Virtual to Win" was organized to support young people who cannot access any technological devices.

The winners of the competition organized within the scope of the campaign were awarded with the technological products required for digital education.
