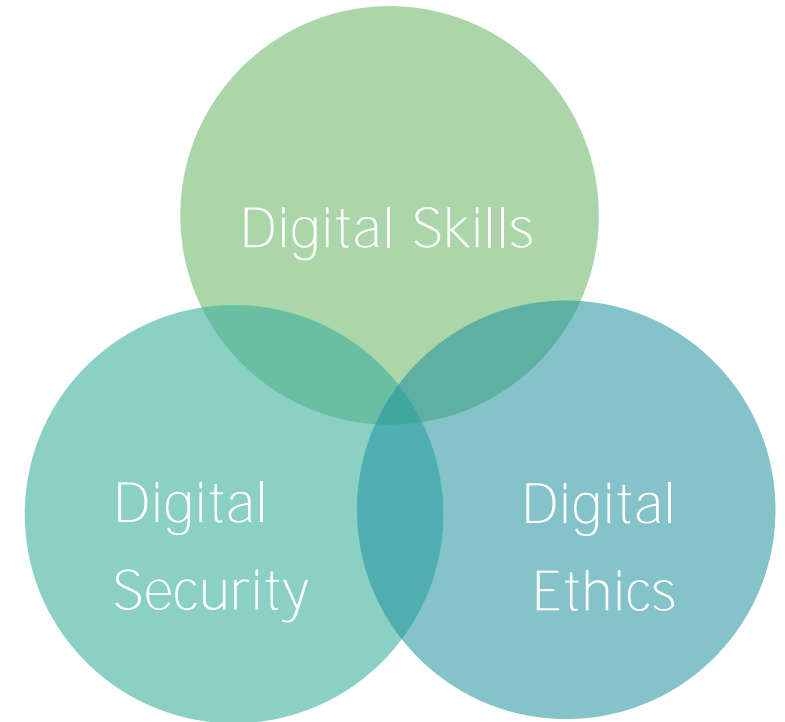
# Challenges in creating smart sustainable cities
