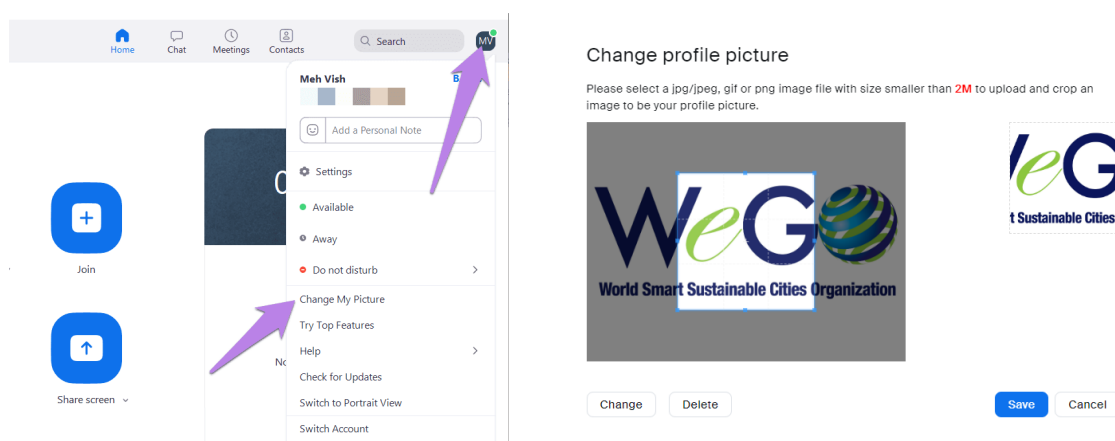
- PC with Windows 10 or Mac with Mac OS X operating system

  - OR a minimum of 30mbps upload/download speed for Wi-Fi (Check your internet speed using <https://speedtest.net/>)

### Setting Your Profile Picture

EXCOM panelist participants are requested to have their cameras turned on for the duration of the meeting. The EXCOM will be recorded with live screens throughout the event. In an unavoidable case that you have to turn off your camera for a short while, please have your profile photo on for a smooth meeting facilitation of the meeting.
