The World Smart Sustainable Cities Organization (WeGO), is a membership-based international association of local governments, smart tech solution providers, and institutions committed to the transformation of cities into smart sustainable cities through facilitating public-private partnerships (PPP).

WeGO was founded by 50 member cities in 2010 as the World e-Governments Organization, hence the acronym. In response to the evolving concept of smart cities, WeGO expanded its vision and mandate at the 4th WeGO General Assembly (2017) and its name to the World Smart Sustainable Cities Organization.

WeGO's Secretariat is based in Seoul, Korea, and has regional offices in East Asia (Chengdu, China), the Mediterranean (Beyoglu, Turkey), Africa (Abuja, Nigeria), Middle East & and North Africa (Abu Dhabi, United Arab Emirates), Latin America (Cuenca, Ecuador), and Central Asia (Almaty, Kazakhstan).

As the leading platform on smart city development, WeGO's mission is to share knowledge and good practices in e-Governance; strengthen administrative efficiency and transparency; advance digital capacity; facilitate civic involvement; bridge the digital divide and inequality; and promote cooperation solidarity among cities and local governments around the world.

WeGO serves for its members as their international platform to improve the quality of life, innovate in the delivery of public services, and strengthen regional competitiveness.

WEGO 2024 ACTIVITIES KICK-OFF EVENT

This year, WeGO is gearing up for an expanded range of initiatives dedicated to advancing humancentric smart cities, aligning with our steadfast commitment to promoting green and sustainable urban development.

The annual Activities Kick-off Event will showcase WeGO's key initiatives for the upcoming year, emphasizing the significance of green and sustainable smart city development. The event will culminate with a networking reception, providing a platform for corporations, local governments, diplomatic missions, academia, and specialists to exchange ideas and explore potential areas for collaboration in the smart city development field.





2ND SEOUL SMART CITY PRIZE

The Seoul Smart City Prize, organized in partnership with Seoul Metropolitan Government, aims to promote an inclusive smart city model addressing underprivileged groups in the Fourth Industrial Revolution. It consists of Tech-InnovaCity, Human-CentriCity, and Leadership categories, emphasizing a balance between human-centric and technology-centric approaches. The prize, in its second edition this year, aims to recognize efforts in people-centered digital transformation, encourage inclusive development in public service digitalization, facilitate global discussions on digitalization's future, and foster networking among smart city stakeholders. Prize winners will receive benefits such as:

- Participating in a tailored capacity-building program for knowledge exchange on the topic of humancentered city development in Seoul, Republic of Korea
- Getting opportunities to collaborate on smart city projects with the Seoul Metropolitan Government
- Joining the 'Seoul Smart City Prize Platform' for networking, and
- Showcasing their achievements at international events.

HIGHLIGHT 2nd Seoul Smart City Prize Ceremony

The 2nd Seoul Smart City Prize ceremony will be held in Seoul in October 2024, during the Seoul Smart Life Week, and it will bring together the distinguished recipients of the prize, encompassing WeGO members and partners such as corporate members, local governments, diplomatic missions, academia, institutions, and experts in smart city development. This event will culminate in the official Prize Ceremony for the finalists, where the winners will be honored for their outstanding contributions to the advancement of smart cities.

WEGO EXCOM MEETING 2024

The WeGO Executive Committee (EXCOM), WeGO's main decision-making body, convenes annually to review the Secretariat's activities and accomplishments in the past year and to decide on key agenda items guiding the organization's direction for the future. Current EXCOM members (2024-2026) are: Abu Dhabi (United Arab Emirates), Abuja (Nigeria), Almaty (Kazakhstan), Chengdu (China), Cuenca (Ecuador), Hebron (Palestine), Kampala (Uganda), Makati (the Philippines), Maputo (Mozambique), Ramgram (Nepal), São Paulo (Brazil), Seberang Perai (Malaysia), Seoul (Republic of Korea), Wellington (New Zealand).



WeGO EXCOM members and invited partners will gather at the WeGO Executive Committee Meeting that will be held in Almaty, Kazakhstan, in September 2024. The 3-days event agenda includes workshops on digitalization, big data technology, startup development, human-oriented urban space, urban ecology, smart city initiatives, and e-sports, as well as a technical tour to areas of interest for smart city development. Almaty, strategically positioned as a regional hub in Central Asia, actively participates in the WeGO organization since 2020. The city has applied for the Seoul Smart City Prize with projects like the "Almaty Data Lake" and starting from 2024 it will serve as a Regional Office (Central Asia) of WeGO. With a thriving IT/R&D sector and a focus on sustainable urban development, Almaty stands out as an emerging smart city, actively seeking global collaborations and recognition.

WeGO Advisory Board is meant to enhance WeGO's promotion of smart cities through Public Private People Partnerships (PPPP) and elevate the organization's profile via connections and consultancies. WeGO-National Information Society Agency (NIA) Joint Feasibility Study Program

The program, aimed to support the implementation of smart city initiatives in a selected WeGO member local government, is the result of an MOU agreement between WeGO and NIA. In 2022, Lima Municipality was selected as the recipient of the study, for their smart tourism initiative "Lima Destino Inteligente" (Lima, Smart Tourism Destination). The final report provided to the city included as a recommendation the implementation of a small pilot project that will be the goal of this program. As such, the initiative seeks to give continuity to the feasibility study carried in Lima during 2022, scale-up WeGO-NIA Feasibility Study, and attract new corporate members with smart tourism technologies.

CAPACITY-BUILDING

YEAR-ROUND | HYBRID



The WeGO Smart City Champions is a 15-week youth program open to individuals under 35 worldwide, and it aims to foster knowledge exchange and build capacities in urban development, sustainability, and smart cities. Through this annual initiative, WeGO provides a platform for global youth from various universities to discuss the importance of their involvement in key processes and frameworks for smart city development. The program, designed to empower young urban leaders, consists of two phases, offering participants certificates upon completion and fostering interaction and networking opportunities through in-person workshops.

ANNUAL TRAINING PROGRAMS

WeGO-NIA JOINT WORKSHOP

Responding to the increasing demand for in-person training, WeGO is organizing a dedicated on-site workshop for city officials from WeGO member cities. The goal of this training workshop is to offer capacity-building opportunities to empower members to adapt to the evolving technologies and trends in smart city development. The three-day program will include practical sessions on Smart City and Digital Government expertise, complemented by a hands-on site visit.

WeGO-SHRDC TRAINING PROGRAM

As part of the Seoul Smart City Prize, winners will be given an opportunity to participate in a tailored capacity building training program in Seoul co-hosted by the Seoul Human Resource Development Center (SHRDC) and WeGO, to experience peer to peer knowledge exchange and share know-hows in advancing human centered city development. In addition, winners also have the opportunity to take part in a feasibility study program customized to the selected cities' smart city development stages and policy needs.

CHENGDU TRAINING PROGRAM

Since 2014, WeGO has been conducting the Chengdu Smart City Training Program in collaboration with its East Asia Regional Office. This program includes lectures and technical tours highlighting the successful smart city initiatives implemented in Chengdu. Its primary goal is to enhance the capabilities of government officials, aiding them in strategically planning smart development through well-considered and cross-referenced policies and measures.

WeGO-IMD Smart City Index



WeGO, in partnership with IMD, recognized cities' efforts in humancentered smart city development through the Smart City Index Report 2023. The IMD Smart City Index is distinctive because it utilizes citylevel data from the Human Development Index. This comprehensive approach considers various indicators, such as life expectancy, education, and income, offering a more holistic view of the quality of life for city residents, as opposed to country-level data. Using the measurements to capture human-centered smart city development, WeGO and IMD have been working together to publish a case study book, showcasing the select winners from the Seoul Smart City Prize 2023. WeGO will explore the Smart City Index for 2024.
