

The World Smart Sustainable Cities Organization (WeGO), is a membership-based international association of local governments, smart tech solution providers, and institutions committed to the transformation of cities into smart sustainable cities through facilitating public-private partnerships (PPP).

WeGO was founded by 50 member cities in 2010 as the World e-Governments Organization, hence the acronym. In response to the evolving concept of smart cities, WeGO expanded its vision and mandate at the 4th WeGO General Assembly (2017) and its name to the World Smart Sustainable Cities Organization.

WeGO's Secretariat is based in Seoul, Korea, and has regional offices in East Asia (Chengdu, China), the Mediterranean (Beyoglu, Turkey), Africa (Abuja, Nigeria), Middle East & and North Africa (Abu Dhabi, United Arab Emirates), Latin America (Cuenca, Ecuador), and Central Asia (Almaty, Kazakhstan).

As the leading platform on smart city development, WeGO's mission is to share knowledge and good practices in e-Governance; strengthen administrative efficiency and transparency; advance digital capacity; facilitate civic involvement; bridge the digital divide and inequality; and promote cooperation solidarity among cities and local governments around the world.

WeGO serves for its members as their international platform to improve the quality of life, innovate in the delivery of public services, and strengthen regional competitiveness.

WEGO ACTIVITIES KICK-OFF EVENT 2025

This year, WeGO is gearing up for an expanded range of initiatives dedicated to advancing humancentric smart cities, aligning with our steadfast commitment to promoting green and sustainable urban development.

3RD SEOUL SMART CITY PRIZE

The Seoul Smart City Prize, organized in partnership with Seoul Metropolitan Government, aims to promote an inclusive smart city model addressing underprivileged groups in the Fourth Industrial Revolution. It consists of Tech-InnovaCity, Human-CentriCity, and Leadership categories, emphasizing a balance between human-centric and technology-centric approaches. The prize, in its third edition this year, aims to recognize efforts in people-centered digital transformation, encourage inclusive development in public service digitalization, facilitate global discussions on digitalization's future, and foster networking among smart city stakeholders. Prize winners will receive benefits such as:

- Participating in a tailored capacity-building program for knowledge exchange on the topic of humancentered city development in Seoul, Republic of Korea
- Getting opportunities to collaborate on smart city projects with the Seoul Metropolitan Government
- Joining the 'Seoul Smart City Prize Platform' for networking, and
- Showcasing their achievements at international events.

Seoul Smart City Prize Ceremony

The 3rd Seoul Smart City Prize ceremony will be held in Seoul in September 2025, during the Seoul Smart Life Week, and it will bring together the distinguished recipients of the prize, encompassing WeGO members and partners such as corporate members, local governments, diplomatic missions, academia, institutions, and experts in smart city development. This event will culminate in the official Prize Ceremony for the finalists, where the winners will be honored for their outstanding contributions to the advancement of smart cities.

WeGO EXCOM members and invited partners will gather at the WeGO Executive Committee Meeting that will be held in Abu-Dhabi, United Arab Emirates, in October 2025. The 3-day event agenda includes sessions on innovation in smart cities, security challenges, digital twins, urban development and advanced technologies, as well as a technical tour to areas of interest for smart city development. The city was one of the winners in Seoul Smart City Prize in 2023 and 2024 for outstanding results in smart city development in the region. At the same time, Abu-Dhabi serves as a Regional Office of WeGO in MENA region. With a thriving IT/R&D sector and a focus on sustainable urban development, Abu-Dhabi stands out as an emerging smart city, actively seeking global collaborations and recognition.

SEOUL SMART CITY INTERNATIONAL COOPERATION PROGRAM - FEASIBILITY STUDY & PROJECT IMPLEMENTATION

The Seoul Smart City International Cooperation Program is an initiative launched and facilitated by the Seoul Metropolitan Government, the World Smart Sustainable Cities Organization (WeGO), and the Seoul Urban Solutions Agency (SUSA) as a follow-up to the Seoul Smart City Prize. The Seoul Smart City International Cooperation Program is directly connected to the Seoul Smart City Prize as it is part of the rewards given to the prize winners. It enables selected winners to implement a pre-feasibility study, which helps them further develop their prize-winning concepts through in-depth analyses, pilot system development, and the creation of long-term plans for project sustainability.

For 2024 São Paulo has been selected as the beneficiary of the program. This year, the program will assist São Paulo in upgrading its Accessible Service Network Map (ASNM) to improve accessibility for individuals with disabilities through comprehensive analysis, database development, and strategic planning.

WeGO-National Information Society Agency (NIA) Joint Feasibility Study Program

The program, aimed to support the implementation of smart city initiatives in a selected WeGO member local government, is the result of an MOU agreement between WeGO and NIA. In 2022, Lima Municipality was selected as the recipient of the study, for their smart tourism initiative "Lima Destino Inteligente" (Lima, Smart Tourism Destination). The final report provided to the city included as a recommendation the implementation of a small pilot project that will be the goal of this program. As such, the initiative seeks to give continuity to the feasibility study carried in Lima during 2022, scale-up WeGO-NIA Feasibility Study, and attract new corporate members with smart tourism technologies.

WEGO SUSTAINABLE SMART CITY CHAMPIONS

Initiated in 2022, the WeGO Sustainable Smart City Champions (or 'WeGO Champions') is an initiative open to students and young leaders worldwide, aimed at enhancing their skills in the field of smart city development. An online course with fourteen (14) lectures is available for free for all students interested via www.cityresiliencetraining.com, with more lectures coming in 2025. The WeGO Champions program will also continue with in-person workshops in global cities such as Athens, Baku, Brescia, Geneva, Milan, Seoul, and Waterloo.

Additionally, in 2025, WeGO will launch its inaugural Global Youth Award. The initiative aims to recognize exceptional global youth leaders excelling in areas such as smart cities, advanced technologies, net-zero, social networks, entrepreneurship, low birth rate, culture, leadership.

WeGO-NIA JOINT WORKSHOP

July | Seoul

WeGO is hosting an exclusive on-site workshop designed for city officials from its member cities. This training aims to enhance participants' capabilities, equipping them with the knowledge and skills needed to navigate emerging technologies and trends in smart city development. Over the course of four days, attendees will engage in expert-led sessions on Smart City and Digital Government, complemented by an immersive site visit for hands-on learning.

Finalists from the Seoul Smart City Prize will get the opportunity to receive a 4-week online and offline training program through a series of virtual live lectures and smart city tours in Seoul.

RESEARCH & DEVELOPMENT

WeGO-IMD Smart City Index



WeGO, in partnership with IMD, recognized cities' efforts in humancentered smart city development through the Smart City Index Report 2023. The IMD Smart City Index is distinctive because it utilizes citylevel data from the Human Development Index. This comprehensive approach considers various indicators, such as life expectancy, education, and income, offering a more holistic view of the quality of life for city residents, as opposed to country-level data. Using the measurements to capture human-centered smart city development, WeGO and IMD have been working together to publish a case study book, showcasing the select winners from the Seoul Smart City Prize 2023. WeGO will explore the development of Smart City Index for 2025.
